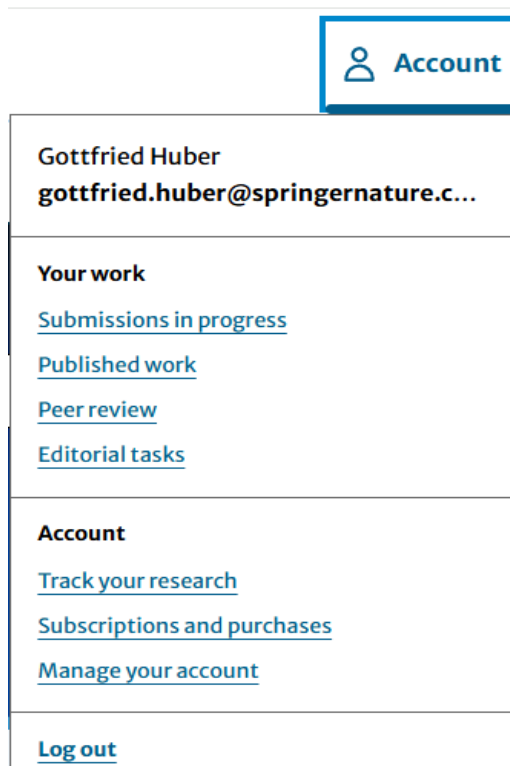

Linked institutions

Enter the code your librarian or administrator provided to link an institution to your account. This will give you access to their library subscription when logged in anywhere, on any device.

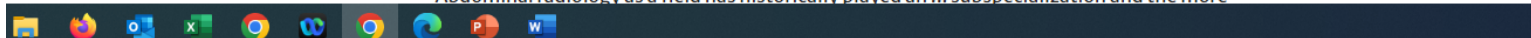

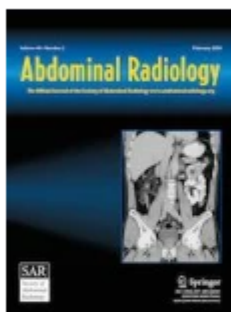
